PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

The Metropolitano is Lima's secure economic and rapid public transportation system connecting Downtown Lima, Miraflores, and Barranco. Buy a metro card for S/. 5, wich does not include credit (each trip costs S/. 2.00)

- Ricardo Palma station is 4 block away from Pariwana Hostel
- Take route A (north) to reach Downtown Lima (Colmena or Jirón de la Unión Stations)
- Take route B or C (south) to reach Barranco's boulevard station

PARIWANA RECOMMENDATIONS

CLASSIC LIMA IN A DAY

If you only have a day to explore Lima start visiting Downtown in the morning. Go from point 50 to 53 in our map. Return to Barranco for lunch, and check out its bohemian-historical atmosphere through point 28 & 29. Finally, come back to Miraflores and enjoy our suggested walk in your way to Pariwana Hostel.

ALTERNATIVE LIMA IN A DAY

Visit Pariwana's suggested walk in Miraflores and then explore Barranco's bohemian district. Have a Ceviche for lunch in point 11 or 14. At night go to point 56 to visit the largest water fountain park in Latin America and enjoy its spectacular show - The Magic Water Circuit. Return to point 1 or 15 for the traditional and delicious Anticuchos & Picarones. If you decide to take this route, you should take an extra day to visit downtown Lima.
